



Welcome to the Acton Community Chorus!

Thank you for coming! Open Rehearsal (September 9, 2019) is your chance to get to know us, see how you like singing with us, and come back next week if you have a good time. We hope to welcome you into our choral family. Everyone is wearing a name tag, so please mingle, ask questions, and make new friends!

What kind of music do we sing? We sing all kinds of music, from classical to contemporary popular, and everything in between. This season, we'll be singing songs of strength and positive change from the traditional and modern musical theater repertory.

When do we perform? We are performing Saturday, January 11, 2020. Our Chamber Singers will also perform occasionally during the season.

How much does it cost to join? Membership is \$85 (\$75 for seniors 65+) per season. You may pay in 3 installments if you wish. There is also a \$10 music fee.

What is our rehearsal schedule? We rehearse from 7:30 - 9:30 p.m. every Monday night at Faith Evangelical Free Church in Acton. Please review the attached schedule before making a commitment.

Do you have to know how to read music? No. Many of our members can sight read music, but many others learn their parts mainly through rehearsals and practice.

What if you don't know your voice part? If you don't know if you're a soprano, alto, tenor, or bass, ask our Music Director for help. She will guide you to the section that's right for you.

How do members help? In addition to singing, members are expected to help with activities such as ticket sales, fundraising, and concert set-up and clean-up. We rely on our members for our success!

Acton Community Chorus (ACC) is a non-profit organization formed in 1984. We sing choral music in a relaxed and cheerful atmosphere and bring that enjoyment to area communities in public concerts.

Rehearsals

- Warm-ups begin promptly at 7:30 pm, so please try to arrive by 7:15 to allow time for sign-in and music distribution.
- We take a 10 minute break with refreshments at 8:30, and conclude at 9:30 pm.
- Each member will be given a rehearsal music folder and a nametag.
- If you are unsure of your voice part, ask our Music Director for help.
- Please bring a pencil each week to mark the music when needed.
- All music must be returned after the concert so it can be reused, so please do not mark in ink, cut, fold or hole-punch the music.
- During concert week there will be additional rehearsals; please see the schedule.
- **Please don't wear perfumes or colognes out of respect for those with allergies.**

Membership

- If paying in installments, payments are due on September 16, October 7, and November 4.
- Along with a weekly rehearsal commitment, members are asked to help with organizational activities such as set-up and/or clean-up and providing refreshments, as well as help in tasks such as publicity and fundraising.
- We depend on our members to help us function. Please pitch in whenever you can!
- As an ACC member, you are eligible to vote for Board of Directors at our next annual meeting in June 2020.
